	<h3>#IMAGINE Clean Water Filers Systems</h3> <p>The #1 NEED of children and families in Africa is clean water. We found a proven and affordable solution (watch video) to meet this critical need. In 2018 we hope to provide clean water filter systems for 300 families (\$50 ea) and 10 schools (\$150 ea). Click to donate \$250, \$500, \$1000, \$2500, \$5000 or more for this project</p>
	<h3>#LetThereBeLight Solar Lamps</h3> <p>The #2 NEED of families is solar lamps. Many families are without consistent electricity and have to rely on dirty, smoky, unsafe, and unhealthy kerosene lanterns and candles for light in their home. We would like to provide 900 \$10 solar lamps for families in 2018. Click to donate \$250, \$500, \$1000, \$2500 or more for this project.</p>
	<h3>Video Projectors & Document Readers</h3> <p>St. Paul's School is academically ranked #90 out of 6000 schools in Uganda. Until last year, they had no technology for the teachers and students. In 2018, we want to provide up to 12 classrooms with Video Projectors/Screens/Document Readers. Each projection set costs \$500 each, Click to donate \$500, \$1000, \$1500 or more.</p>
	<h3>Leadership Conference for 200</h3> <p>In October of 2018 we are planning a leadership conference for 200+ pastors and school chaplains. We will be providing food, clean water filters, and solar study lamps for each participant (\$80 per leader). Click to donate \$400, \$800, \$1200, \$2400, or more.</p>

Computers | Laptops | Wifi

St. Paul's School has 600 students with 40 staff and teachers. No teachers or students had access to computers or the internet. Last year we were able to provide 13 desktops, 8 laptops, desks, chairs, and wifi for the school's computer lab.

\$11,500 Project Completed



Enclosed Cafeteria

St. Paul's school provides 2 meals per day to nearly 700 students, staff, and volunteers. The cafeteria had a roof but no walls so the children and the food would get drenched during the rainy season. Funds were provided to fully enclose the facility.

\$12,000 Project Completed



Eye Exams | Prescription Glasses

Teachers and students had never eye exams. We partnered with the Lions Club International, local Lions Club, and the medical university, 700 eye exams were given. and every child and adult who needed prescription glasses received them.

\$25,000 in services and glasses



Soccer Balls & Sports Equipment

St. Paul's children were using soccer balls made out of plastic bags and string. Indestructible soccer balls were brought from California along with other sports equipment for the school..

\$1000 Project Completed (but more help is welcomed)



96-Bed Girls Dormitory

Some young girls (8-13 years old) were walking 1-4 hours per day to school. Other girls were orphans and had no one to pay their school fees or provide them with food and clothing. The solution was a 96-bed Sandi House dormitory that was built in the memory of Sandi Kluth that passed away at 54 years old from cancer.
